

The Conseil des arts et des lettres du Québec (Conseil) has concluded a collaboration agreement with the City of Paris and the Récollets international reception and exchange center (Les Récollets), in order to expand the international network of workshops and residences offered to Québec artists and writers.

The artists participating in this program enjoy complete autonomy and define the objectives of their stay and elaborate the parameters and conditions for its realization in collaboration with one or more artistic collaborators from France. When they register, applicants must submit a letter of intent from the host organization that undertakes to offer them professional support during their residency and that specifies the nature of the collaboration that they intend to establish in conjunction with the project.
