

RECIPROCAL RESIDENCY



Artist and studio-apartment residency exchanges

SOUTH KOREA ↔ QUÉBEC

Since 2015, visual artists can reside at the National Museum of Modern and Contemporary Art's (MMCA) Goyang residence, in Seoul. In return, a South Korean visual artist will be hosted in Montréal, Québec at the Darling Foundry.

The MMCA offers the Québec artist free use of a studio-apartment as well as work spaces. The residence complex offered to the Conseil is the Goyang Residency. It includes 18 studio-residences, studio workshops including a wood and metal workshop, exhibition space, communal area and collective kitchen, guest rooms, walled garden and terrace. For its artists in residence, the MMCA organizes Open Studio days, meetings with curators, gallery directors and representatives of other Korean museums as well as cultural mediation activities.
