

In 2014, the Conseil des arts et des lettres du Québec (Conseil) concluded a partnership agreement with the State Government of Upper Austria to create an exchange program of studio-apartments and studios for creation and resourcing for the visual and digital arts.

In the context of this exchange, a Québec artist can reside in one of the nine studios included in the Atelierhaus Salzamt international artists residency space in the City of Linz and an artist from Upper Austria can take advantage of a creation residency of the same duration at the SPOROBOLE centre, in the City of Sherbrooke, Québec province.
