Wishing to develop links with artists from the Nordic countries, the Conseil des arts et des lettres du Québec (Conseil) has collaborated, since 1997, with the Finnish Artists Studio Foundation (FASF) for its international artist and studio-apartment exchange program.

Each year, the FASF makes available to a Québec artist a studio-apartment in an architectural complex in the city of Espoo.

This exchange agreement enable a Québec artist to engage in a four-month sojourn in Finland and a Finnish artist in a four-month sojourn in Québec, at the Méduse coop.
