

In 2017, the Conseil des arts et des lettres du Québec (Conseil), in partnership with Québec's Ministry of Culture and Communications (MCC), the Ministry of International Relations and La Francophonie (MRIF) and Québec's Office in Dakar, has entered into a collaboration agreement with Senegal's Ministry of Culture (MCS) aimed at establishing a program of Artist and studio-apartment residency exchanges in the visual arts field.

Under this agreement, two Québec artists will undertake a two-month residency in Dakar, Senegal, in the Village des Arts, while two Senegalese artists will undertake at two-month residency in Montréal, Québec, at Centre Clark.
