



## Research and creation residency in Nantes

# FRANCE ◀▶ QUÉBEC

In 2016, the Conseil des Arts et des lettres (Conseil) has concluded a partnership agreement with le Lieu unique, scène nationale de Nantes (Lieu Unique) and la Ville de Nantes, aimed at setting up an artist and studio-apartment residency exchanges between Quebec and France.

In the context of this exchange, a Québec visual artist can reside for a two-month sojourn at Lieu Unique, in Nantes. In return, a French visual artist will be hosted in Québec for a two-month sojourn at AXENÉO7, in Gatineau.

A studio-apartment and work space will be made available to the artist by le Lieu unique.
