

PROGRAM MANAGEMENT DURING THE COVID-19 PANDEMIC – ARTISTS

Information as of May 26, 2020

The information in this table takes precedence over regular program information.

Because of the changing nature of the current situation, the CALQ cannot guarantee response times indicated in the program information will be respected. To facilitate the decision-making process, please submit your application only when you are certain that the project or program of activities as submitted is feasible. Factors that may allow their implementation include, for example:

- the official re-opening of the sector (as decreed by the authorities);
- permission from authorities regarding travel and gatherings;
- the re-opening of borders;
- the signing of contracts.

The CALQ will review the project and reserves the right to deem it ineligible if its integrity is compromised, for example, by the cancellation of a festival or the closing of a venue that is part of the program.

Applications will not be accepted by mail until further notice, nor will the CALQ mail letters, including those that explain the reasons for the ineligibility of an application.

At this time, the CALQ cannot respond to requests regarding the evaluation scores.

Mon dossier CALQ is the preferred channel for submitting an application and tracking its progress. Please register for it and keep your profile information up to date.

If you cannot register for *Mon dossier CALQ* or use it to submit an application for a program, please use WeTransfer to submit applications or grant use reports, using the instructions provided.

From now on, grant or funding use reports normally due must be received and approved before a new application is submitted.

If the dates for a supported project have had to be modified because of the pandemic, please complete the [Modification of Project Dates - COVID-19 form](#) and return it to the person responsible for your file at the CALQ. The changes will appear in your online file.

From now on, except for grants for the circulation of works that are paid out upon presentation of the contracts, grants will be paid based on the start date of the project as follows:

- Payment on the 1st day of the month for projects starting between the 1st and the 14th of the month.
- Payment on the 15th day of the month for projects starting between the 15th and the last day of the month.

A Social Insurance Number (S.I.N.) is required for payment.

Travel	Ineligibility of projects taking place in Québec before June 1 and outside Québec before September 1, 2020. The application must demonstrate the feasibility of the project as presented.	Suspension of the rule requiring that the project be submitted 4 weeks before its start.
Strategic Opportunities and Career Planning	The application must demonstrate the feasibility of the project as presented.	The application can be submitted any time before the start of the project.
